(requirement ID 14, 19, 22, 23, 32, 48) Is it correctly understood that: 1. the proposal should only contain confirmation that we will provide these descriptions/ specifications at a later time 2. the proposal should not contain these descriptions</p>	<p>There have been some questions regarding Appendix 3 and the requirements related to Appendix 2. Below is a consolidated summary of the changes that have been made.</p> <p>In general, for the requirements related to Appendix 2, there are certain answers/documents we would like to receive as part of the tender response on April 23, in order to evaluate them and use them in the dialogue meetings in August. These requirements will be set as Describe requirements (D).</p> <p>For other requirements, we would like to review and engage in an active dialogue about the documents during the clarification phase. These requirements are therefore set as Confirm requirements (C), meaning that suppliers must confirm that they are willing to submit documentation and participate in the dialogue later.</p> <p>Below is an overview of the requirements that clarifying questions have been raised about, and whether they are a Describe (D) requirement—because we want to see the documentation and responses in April—or a Confirm (C) requirement, as we only need confirmation that the supplier will prepare the documentation and response in connection with the clarification phase.</p> <p>Confirm requirements: 17, 19, 22, 33, 34, 35, 36, 48, 49, 50, 52, 53, 56 and 60. Describe requirements: 14, 18, 23, 32 and 98.</p> <p>Requirement 14 has been changed as follows: - Weight reduced from 4 to 1 - The following bullet point has been removed from the requirement: "be included as an attachment in the Supplier's response and pricing basis"</p> <p>A new version of Appendix 3 with the changes is uploaded</p>
Text in regular and bold - significance	2026-03-13	In Sub-appendices 18 both regular and bold text is used in the table. There is no reference to this in the text. Is the text in either regular og bold significant?	<p>It is stated in Appendix 18 and Appendix 23 that the bold text in the cases (sub-appendices 18a1–18h1) must be demonstrated during the demo sessions.</p> <p>What is not written in Appendix 18 or 23 is that the vendors will in June receive a summary of the functionalities to be demonstrated in August. This summary will be based entirely on the elements that appear in bold in the sub-appendices.</p>

Anesthesia: Meaning of Caveat	2026-03-13	In, eg. Sub-appendix 18A1 "The pregnant woman", it reads "The anesthesiologist must be able to quickly obtain an overview of any relevant information in relation to anesthesia – i.e. - Caveat, blood type, medication.....should the word "Caveat" be understood as warning of allergies and intolerances, which were formerly named CAVE or is the meaning entirely different?	In all cases in appendix 18 the word "Caveat" could be understood as CAVE.
Will proposals in Danish be allowed?	2026-03-16	Section 7.8 in the Tender Terms states that: The tender, including appendices, must be written in English, and any negotiation rounds must be conducted in English or Danish. Technical documentation, including screenshots, that is not available in English may be submitted in Danish. Question: Will the client consider allowing proposals to be submitted in Danish as this would allow for a consistent language from proposal to negotiation?	According to section 7.8 in Tender Terms, the proposal must be submitted in English. "The tender, including appendices, must be written in English, and any negotiation rounds must be conducted in English or Danish. Technical documentation, including screenshots, that is not available in English may be submitted in Danish. "
