Nordic Collaboration on Invasive Alien Species: Networks, Resources, and Early Warning Systems

Deadline for tender questions: 08-03-2026

The following questions were submitted before the deadline:

Question #1

Can a union, whose headquarters are based in a non-Nordic country, be eligible to apply as a lead applicant? Or could only entities registered in a Nordic country apply as the lead applicant?

Answer:

The project group must have at least two entities that are registered in a Nordic country and that are actively involved in the project. This also means that such a union can participate in a project group and are thus eligible. But not as a single applicant.

Question #2

For the invasive species call, is the Focus on management actions or can also Research on impacts of invasive species be funded?

Answer:

It is not impossible, but management actions are at the core of the project.

Question #3

Would it be possible to do a project only for terrestrial species or does it have to cover both terrestrial and aquatic species?

This is not specifically mentioned in the tender material. The idea of this tender is to create a network and a platform that will be able to address the issue of invasive species very broadly in the Nordic region.
